Remember Yom HaShabbat (The Sabbath Day), to keep it kadosh (holy). – Shemot (Exodus) 20:8

Spring	1. Pesakh (Passover) 14 th day of Nisan (1st month)	Passover of death angel, First born lamb sacrificed, Blood of the sacrificial lamb on door as a sign. 	2. Khag Matzot (Feast of Unleavened Bread) 14 th through 20 th days of Nisan	Unleavened Bread, Manna. Where Leaven = Sin. Yeshua's body = Bread. He is the Bread of life (sinless). Bethlehem = Bet Leckem (House of Bread).	Lev 23:6-8; Exo 12:15-20; 23:15;34:18; Deu 16:1-8; 16-17; Num 28:17-25; Jos 5:8-12; Mat 26:1-5; Luk 2:41-43; 12:1; 22:1; Act 12:3 1st Cor 5:6-8; Col 2:16-17
	3. Omer Reishit (Firstfruits) 1 st Day of week after Passover	Firstfruits of the barley harvest. On first day of week after the Sabbath following Pesakh. Yeshua is the firstfruits of the resurrection from the dead.	Lev 23:9-14; Exo 23;19; 34:26; Deu 26:1-4; Jos 5:8-12; Luk 24:44-47; Joh 5:28-29; 1 Cor 15:20-23; Jer 2:3; Jam 1:18; Rev 14:4
	4. Khag Shavu'ot (Feast of Weeks / Pentecost) 50 days after Omer Reishit	Firstfruits of the wheat harvest. Always on 1 st day (Sun). 7 Weeks + 1 day (50 Days) after Firstfruits [of barley]. Ru'akh HaKodesh (Holy Spirit) came in power.	Lev 23:15-22; Exo 23:16-17; 34:22-24; Deu 16:9-12; 16-17; Num 28:26; 2 Chro 8:13 Acts 2:1-4; 20:16; Rom 8:19-23;1 Cor 16:8
Fall	5. Yom Teru'ah (Day of Trumpets) or Rosh Hashanah (New Year) 1 st day of Tishri (7 th month)	The day of Awakening Blast. Call to assemble for war. Day no man knows (celebrated as 2 days; 1 st /2 nd Tishri). Yeshua's coming in clouds with trumpet blast. "Natzal"	Lev 23:23-25; Num 10:1-10; 29:1-6; Mat 24:31, 36; Mar 13:32; Joh 5:25-29; 1 Cor 15:52; 1 The 4:16
	6. Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) 10 th day of Tishri	Day of the Lord, Sins atoned for. Day Man judged. All wear white. Day of fasting to afflict oneself. Trumpet. Yeshua's return to judge with believers following in white.	Lev 16:1-34; 23:26-32; 25:9; Num 29:7-11; Eze 45:20; Act 27:9; Rev 19:11-16
	7. Khag Sukkot (Feast of Booths / Tabernacles) 15 th – 22 nd days of Tishri	Joyous dwelling in temporary booths 7 days. Recalls God dwelling with men wandering in the desert. We dwell temporarily with Yeshua in millennial kingdom.	Lev 23:33-43; Exo 23:16-17; 34:22-24; Num 29:12-39; Deu 16:13-17; Eze 3:4; Neh 8:14; Eze 45:25; Hos 12:9; Zec 14:16; Joh 7:2



Sh'mini Atzeret (Eighth day assembly) [of Sukkot] - Rejoicing in Torah - Lev 23:39
Khanukah (Feast of Dedication) – 25th Kisleev to 2nd Tevet: John 10:22; Maccabees
Purim (Feast of Lots) – 14th / 15th of Adar: Esther 9:29 - 32
